

## DATES OF INTEREST & NEW TOWN ORDINANCES RE: SEAPOINT & CRESCENT BEACHES

The Town passed several changes to the Town Ordinances dealing with parking and dogs at Seapoint/Crescent Beaches that are now in effect. In the absence of an Animal Control Officer, the following is for your use in enforcing these new ordinances:

### PARKING

**OCT 1 to MAY 14: No Restrictions.** Both Residents and Non-Residents may park in any legal parking area-including lot adjacent to the beach itself. (T.C. 12.12.030)

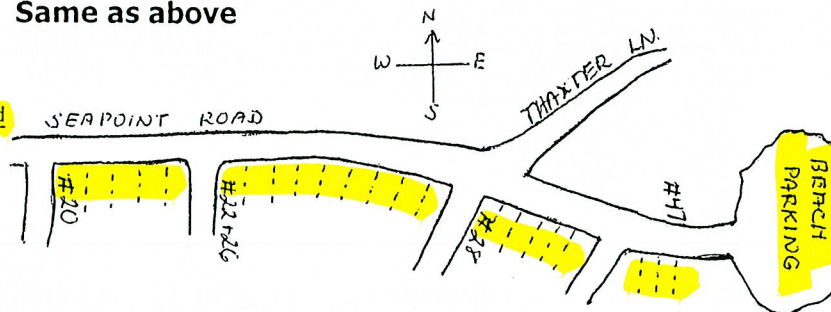
**HOURS: Allowed-**3:01 AM to 11:00 PM

**Closed-**11:01 PM to 3:00 AM

**MAY 15 to SEP 30: Restricted.** All parking in all legal areas is restricted to Kittery Residents Only. (T.C. 12.12.030B). Vehicles must display Kittery Dump Sticker or Guest Permit [issued by Chief of Police]. (T.C. 12.12.030C2)

**HOURS: Same as above**

NOTE: **Highlighted** areas depict ALL legal parking areas.



### DOGS

**OCT 01 to MAY 14:** All dogs (resident & non-resident alike) allowed on Seapoint/Crescent Beaches. May be off-leash, "under the control of their owner/keeper". No time-of-day restrictions. [T.C. 12.12.080}

**MAY 15 to SEP 30: Only** dogs licensed to **Kittery Residents** are allowed on Seapoint/Crescent Beaches. [T.C. 12.12.080]

**JUN 15 to SEP 10: Time-of-Day Restrictions-** Dogs licensed to **Kittery Residents** may only be on Seapoint/Crescent Beaches **prior to 10:00 AM** or **after 5:00 PM**. They may be off-leash, "under the control of their owner/keeper". **NO** dogs are allowed, leashed or off-leash, between 10:01 AM and 5:00 PM [T.C. 12.12.080]

**SEP 11 to SEP 30: No Time-of Day Restrictions...but,** restricted to dogs licensed to **Kittery Residents**.

**Q:** How do we identify "dogs licensed to Kittery Residents"?

**A:** All dogs licensed in Maine have a blue license tag, shaped in the outline of the State of Maine, bearing a serial number. Serial Numbers: **76501 to 77500**: assigned to Kittery. **No tag? Dog not allowed.**

**POOPER/SCOOPER:** Owners/keepers are required to pick up and remove dog feces from the beaches **and take it with them**. Failure to collect the feces violates Town Code 12.12.080. Failure to take the bag with them constitutes littering, a violation of 17 MRSA § 2263-A (Civil Infraction).
